A candidate should possess the eligibility of 10+2 qualification from the Board of Intermediate, Government of Andhra Pradesh & Telangana, or any other equivalent examination recognized as equivalent thereto, with Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry as his/her optional subjects.					
In order to step into a four-year degree course in Engineering, a student except those from the NRI quota must qualify in "Engineering, Agricultural Sciences and Medical Common Entrance Test" (EAMCET), a State-Level Entrance Test conducted by the Govt. of Andhra Pradesh.
