The Managements and Principals of all the Engineering colleges under JNTUA were invited to attend a meeting at JNTUA on 30.08.2023. The agenda of the meeting was related to R23 Regulations, Academic Matters and Examination Related issues. The Honourable Vice Chancellor, JNTUA who chaired the meeting, informed the Autonomous institutions to follow the academic guidelines as given below:

- Total number of credits shall be 160 for B.Tech. programme and there is no exemption of credits and no additional credits to be studied for the award of B.Tech. Degree.
- The courses in first and second semesters may be swapped to balance the teaching Workload.
- 3. There may be up to 20% of deviation in enhancing the content of each course.
- 4. Flexibility to redefine Course Objectives and Outcomes.
- Flexibility in offering Professional & Open Electives, verticals/tracks under Open Electives, Skill Enhancement courses.

Further Director Academic and Planning, JNTUA has sent an email dated 31/08/2023, sharing the R23 academic regulations, course structure and first year syllabus applicable for the students admitted into the B.
