Organogram - MITS Deemed to be University




Figure 5.1: Organizational chart

Grievance Redressal Cell

As per All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) regulations regarding the establishment of Mechanism for Grievance Redressal in Technical Institutions, a Grievance Redressal Committee (GRC) is formed to address the grievances of the students. The Vice-Principal – Administration is nominated as the Co-ordinator for the Grievance Redressal Committee. The student grievance can be lodged online at the website <https://mitsmadanapalle.edugrievance.com/> or through <https://forms.office.com/r/vke9XhMFac> or send through e-mail to grc@mits.ac.in or in writing to "[The Coordinator-GRC, MITS, Madanapalle - 517325](#)" For each grievance, reported to the Committee, an enquiry committee shall be constituted under the Chairmanship of the Principal and he shall nominate the appropriate members.

The Principal will nominate the co-opt members to the Enquiry Committee as per the type and the nature of the grievance and the situation. Coordinator-GRC will chair the meeting for that particular matter. If any of the complainants are not satisfied with the decision of the Grievance Redressal Committee, they may approach the Ombudsman in JNTUA directly. The Ombudsman shall hear to those grievances and disposes them. Within one month of receipt for early redressal of grievance. The online students Grievance Redressal Portal <https://samadhaan.ugc.ac.in/> is initiated by the University Grants Commission, and <https://www.aicte-india.org/feedback/> by AICTE to facilitate students and staff to lodge his/her grievance and provide a mechanism for redressal of their grievances.

About Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) Internal Complaints Mechanism

MITS - Deemed to be University has constituted Internal Complaint Committee (ICC) in pursuance of guidelines issued by Supreme Court, UGC and as per the provisions of the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition & Redressal) Act, 2015, Anti-Sexual Harassment Cell (Internal Complaints Committee) is reconstituted to provide for the effective enforcement of the basic human rights of gender equality and guarantee against sexual harassment and abuse, and to provide conducive atmosphere in the campus, to all the staff members, employees and students of MITS. The committee has a team of nine members among them one person is Rotatory club president. The committee works for the prevention, prohibition and redressed of sexual harassment of women at MITS, as MITS has Zero tolerance towards sexual harassment.

Madanapalle Institute of Technology & Science - Deemed to be University is committed to provide a safe workplace for all women employees and girl students. In this direction, MITS has implemented Government of India's Prevention of Sexual Harassment (POSH) Act of 2013 and as amended in 2016. A committee is in place to address any Sexual harassment related complaints. Girl students or lady faculty members can lodge any sexual harassment complaint: posh@mits.ac.in or contact POSH Cell Coordinator Mrs. U. Vijaya Lakshmi or Principal, MITS. Having raised the bar of responsibility and accountability in the Vishaka Guidelines, the Supreme Court placed an obligation on workplaces, institutions and those in positions of responsibility, to uphold working women's fundamental right to equality and dignity at the workplace. Three key obligations were imposed on institutions to meet that standard, namely: 4 (AIR 1997 Supreme Court 3011)

- ◆ Prohibition
- ◆ Prevention
- ◆ Redress

In 2013, the Government of India notified the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act (referred to as Act hereinafter). Consistent with the Vishaka judgment, the Act aspires to ensure women's right to workplace equality, free from sexual harassment through compliance with the above mentioned three elements. In pursuance of guidelines issued by Supreme Court, UGC and as per the provisions of the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition & Redressal) Act, 2013, Anti-Sexual Harassment Cell (Internal Complaints Committee) is reconstituted to provide for the effective enforcement of the basic human rights of gender equality and guarantee against sexual harassment and abuse, and to provide conducive atmosphere in the campus, to all the staff members, employees and students of MITS.

Objectives of the Committee

- To prevent sexual harassment by promoting gender amity among staff, students and other employees.
- To deal with cases of sexual harassment in a time bound manner, aiming at ensuring support services to the victimized, prevention and termination of the harassment.
- Recommend appropriate redressal and punitive action against the guilty to the Management.
- To comply with the provisions of the Sexual Harassment at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 (Act) and to develop and implement a policy against sexual harassment of women at the MITS.
- To uphold Women's Right to Protection against Sexual Harassment and for the prevention and redressal of sexual harassment of women.
- To evolve a permanent mechanism for the prevention, prohibition and redressal of sexual harassment of women at MITS.
- To actively promote a social, physical and psychological environment that will raise awareness about and deter acts of sexual harassment of women.
- To undertake all necessary and reasonable steps including the constitution of appropriate committees for purposes of gender sensitization and to conduct enquiries into complaints of sexual harassment.

The Internal Complaint Committee (ICC) comprising of the following faculty is reconstituted to deal with issues of "Gender Based Violence" and to conduct gender sensitization programmes. The Innovation and Incubation Centre (IIC) plays a significant role in promoting innovation and entrepreneurship by organizing internal hackathons, idea generation programs, prototype development activities, and competitions, enabling students to translate innovative ideas into viable products. The institution has also established Centres of Excellence and industry-supported laboratories, which provide hands-on training in emerging technologies and support research activities of students and faculty members.

To promote self-directed learning, students are encouraged to enrol in Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs) offered through platforms such as SWAYAM and NPTEL, with provision for credit transfer as per university norms. The institution integrates ICT-enabled teaching practices through the use of smart classrooms, digital learning resources, and modern software tools such as MATLAB, SCI Lab, CATIA, and STACKPRO. 


Figure16.1: Students Placements details




Figure16.2: Students Placements %




Figure16.3: Highest salary details of placed students




Figure 16.4: Median salary details of placed students
