

**A Report on “ Anti-Ragging Week 12th – 17th August 2024” Coordinated and Submitted by

Madanapalle Institute of Technology & Science, Madanapalle, Annamayya District, organized Anti-Ragging Week Celebration during 12-17 August 2024.

Day 1: Day one of Anti-Ragging Week Celebration was to bring awareness among students on Anti-Ragging. MITS celebrated with an introductory session on Anti-Ragging which was held on 12th of August 2024. In the forenoon session, the student volunteers of Anti-Ragging, Anti-Ragging squad and faculty members went to all the classrooms of the students of I, II, III & IV years and delivered speeches and slogans to the students.

In the afternoon session, the Anti-Ragging Day Celebrated at MITS Auditorium at 4 ‘o’ clock. For this event, all the prominent dignitaries of the college Dr. C. Yuvaraju, Principal, MITS as the chief guest of the day, Dr. Thulasiram Naidu, Advisor - R&D as the special guest of the day, Dr. K. Chandramohan, Coordinator - Anti-Ragging Squad, and Dr. G. He also stated that Students should think about their goals seriously and equip all their necessary technical skills, good communication skills, respective domain knowledge etc., from time to time before they reach final year, so that students can get a good job in campus placements at the beginning of the final year itself. Therefore, he stated that every student should be goal oriented and eradicate ragging completely from their mind and reality.



Dr. Thulasiram Naidu said that all kinds of primitive measures are followed to drive away the ragging demon in the college, we are

regularly conducting awareness programs, in that, police, legal experts and judges will be the guest of honours, so everyone will get the alert of ragging along with its act.

Dr. Chandramohan said that anti-ragging week celebration began from 12th August 2024, in MITS as per the instructions of UGC and AICTE, and as a part of Anti-Ragging Week.
