**Inauguration**

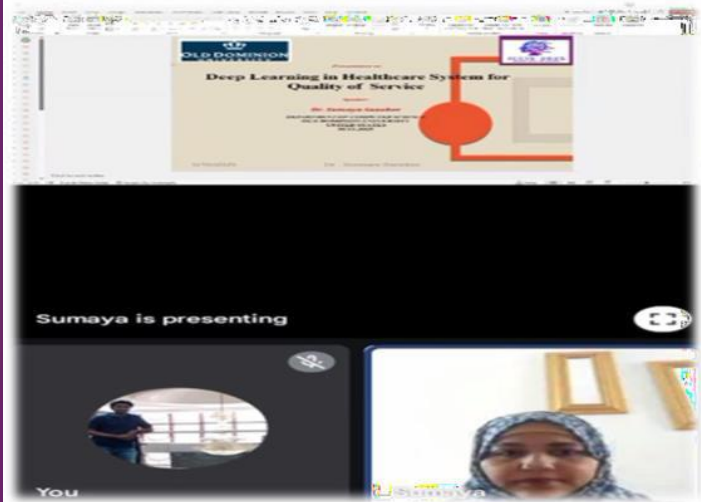

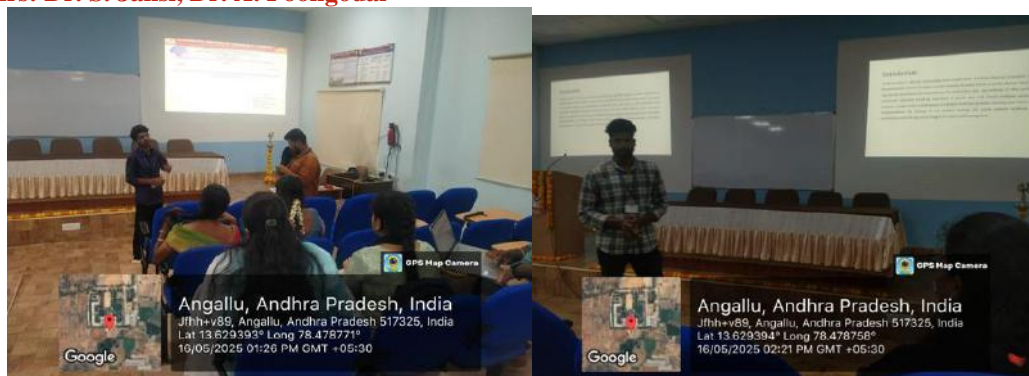

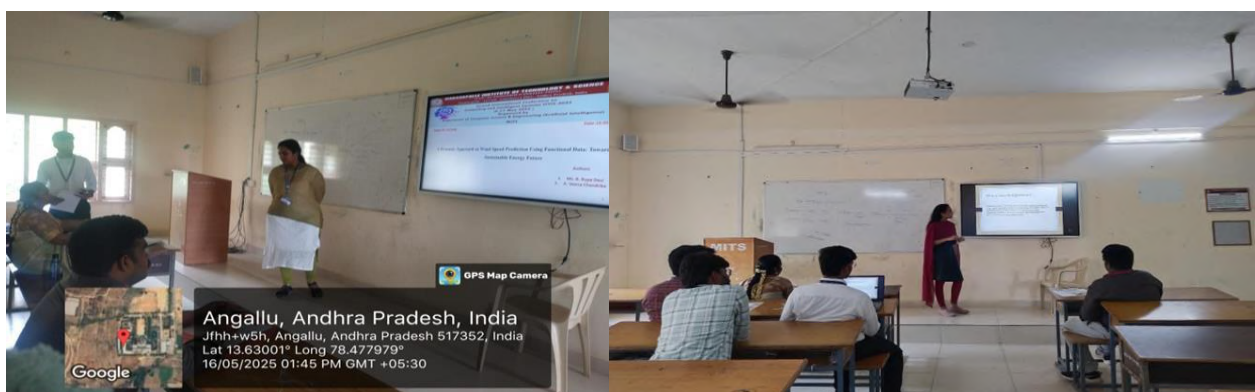
