The Swachtaa Hi Seva campaign has made substantial progress in promoting cleanliness and sanitation across the country. Some key achievements include:

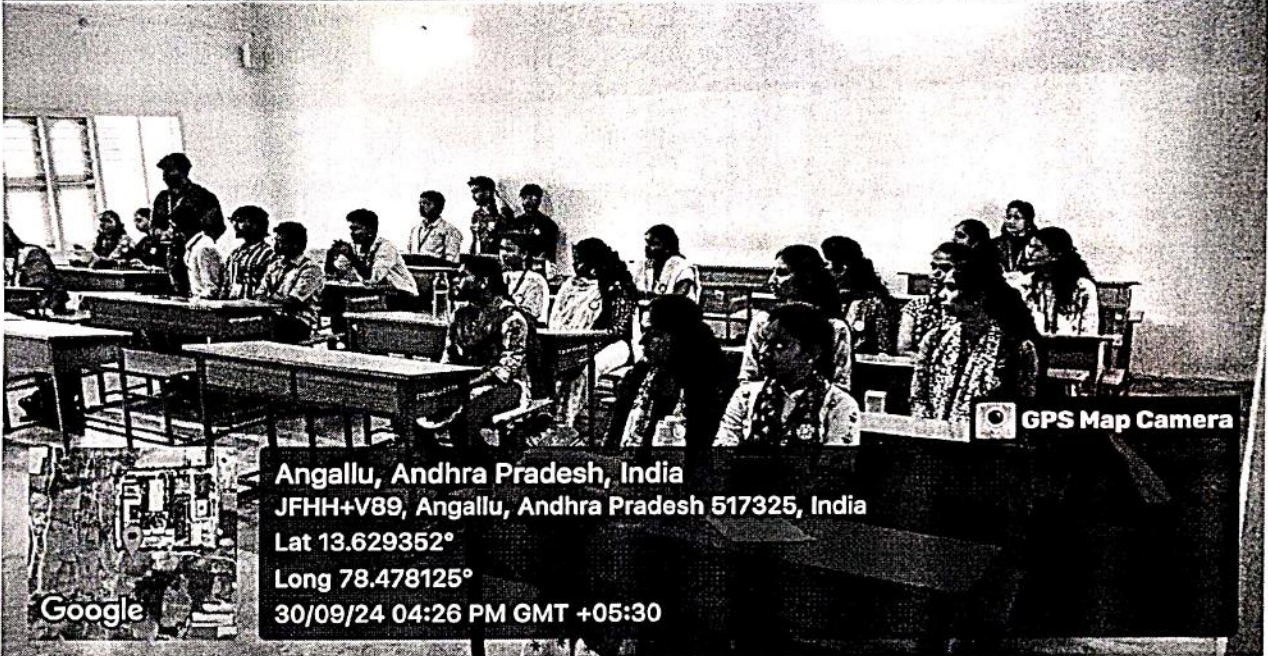
1. **Increased Awareness:** The campaign has successfully raised awareness about the importance of cleanliness and hygiene practices among citizens.
