Quickobook shares the largest healthcare network across the East India empaneled with 10K + doctors, 200+ Hospitals and 1Million + lives touched. The company operates with a team size of 18 people under direct employment and 2252 working as under indirect employment as registered QOB franchisee. Received 50 lakhs grant from Govt. of India and recently raised 2 Crore fund from NVCL for a present valuation of 20 Crore. Winner at 1 st runner at i2i entrepreneurship competition across the Pan India and incubated at IIM Calcutta, Nass-com, Bengal Chamber of Commerce, NIT, IIT Guwahati, IIE Guwahati. Quickobook, has been selected among the best 20 starts up across the Pan India and received applauds from the Prime Minister Narendra Modi in writing and virtually too. Quickobook recently has got an international publication on the books of university journal and selected for Spot funding for the India Biggest reality show reality show Shark Tank India Season 2.
