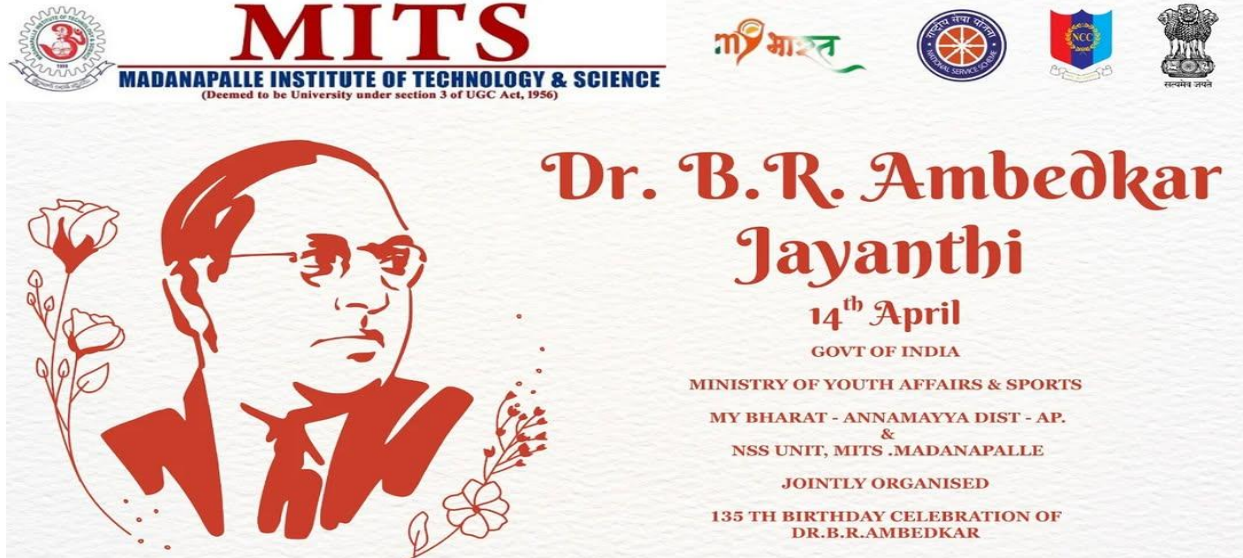


A Report on “Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Jayanthi” Organized by NSS CELL
