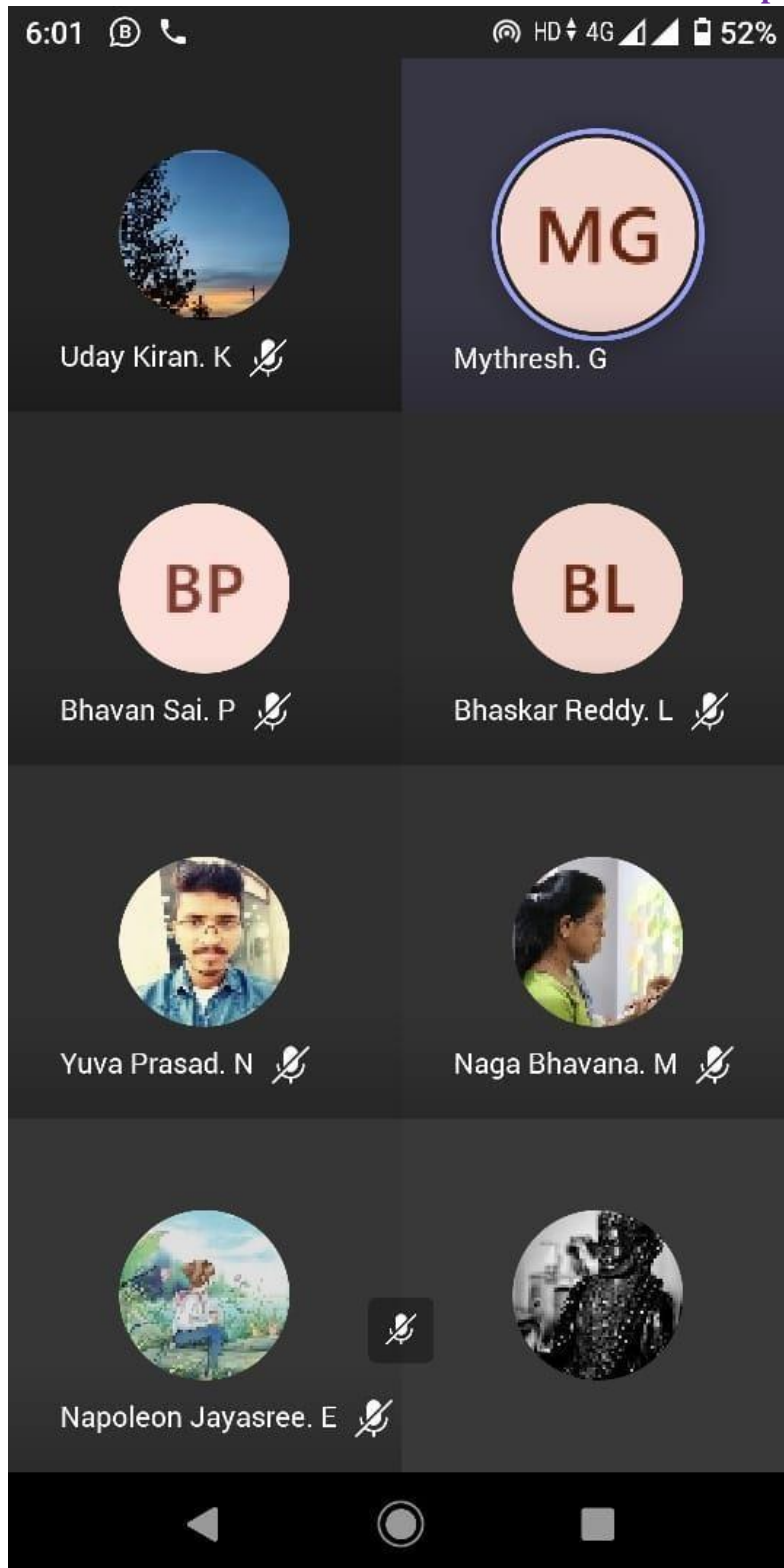
## DAY 2:
