- 7. Confidence Boost By sharing ideas in a supportive environment, participants gained confidence in their ability to contribute entrepreneurial ideas, even in a quick-thinking setting.
- 8. Increased Awareness of Real-World Problems Brainstorming around real-life challenges inspired participants to think more about everyday problems that could spark business ideas.
- 9. Foundation for a Learning Mindset The experience introduced participants to entrepreneurial skills they can develop, such as opportunity recognition, innovation, and resourcefulness.
