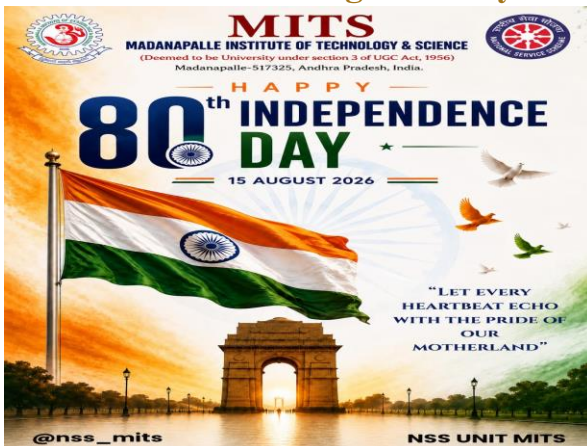


A Report on
