Internal Complaints Committee of MITS organised International Women's Day on 8 March 2018. The programme started at 4.30 pm in the Main Seminar Hall with invocation by the students of MBA. Dr.Geetha Devi, Chairperson of MITS-ICC greeted the women staff and the girl students, and she told about the MITS-ICC and how it addresses women issues.
