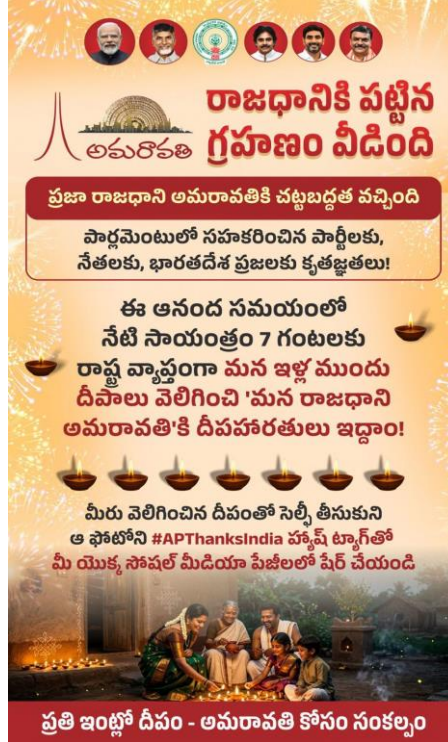


A Report on “Rajadhaniki Pattina Grahanam Veedindi” Organized by NSS CELL

Introduction:
