10:00 AM to 12:00 PM: Inauguration

After Lamping the light, Saraswathi Vandanam and honoring the guests, the three-day conference started with Welcome address by Dr. Dhowmya Bhatt, Dean IQAC, SRMIST, New Delhi. 5:00 PM to 6:30 PM – Team Development plenary talk – Moderator by Dr. Gopal Babu

All the resource team participated and deliberated the essential features of a team leader and the qualities of team members. TEAM means Togetherness, Empathy, Assessment (Right Evaluation) and Mentorship (Hand holding).



Day 1 concluded with Team activity of making Video on UHV and Plenary sharing at Main Conference Hall.

Day 2 – (04/04/2025)

7:30 AM to 8:30 AM- Team meeting with Shri Ganesh Ji.

All the Volunteers of Southern region were gathered to introduce themselves and take up new projects related to UHV. Four volunteers along with me has joined the session from SCR (Andhra Pradesh and Telangana).

9:30 AM to 11:30 AM

Team development meeting with discussion on few key points and projects was held at main conference hall handled by Dr. Kumar Sambhav and Shri Umesh Jadhav

Key points:

1. Moving from responsibility to owing responsibility

2. Ownership of Task at hand (No need for reminders)
3. Sharing Concerns & Challenges with Mentor with transparency.
4. Developing a team for the task.
5. Taking more initiatives.
6. Finishing what you start
7. Complimenting and not complaining
8. Readiness to the Feedback
9. Learning new skills by oneself.
10. Ability to continue in spite of all setbacks.
11. Finding creative ways and solution to accomplish.
12. Ensuring source of happiness inside, not outside.

The process of face to face self-funded UHV FDP is explained by the FDP team led by Mr. Ajay Pal. Later the implantation of UHV in schools and villages of Madhya Pradesh by RAS (Anand Department), Govt. of M.P is explained in detail. Every Educational institute are requested to adopt 5 schools, 3 villages and one jail to share the values.

Plenary sharing by Prof H. D. Charan, Former VC PTU. He shared his experience about implementation of UHV courses in the curriculum at Punjab Technical University as a Vice-Chancellor. He told that as a VC, first he has completed the UHV FDPs and asked his faculty to attend the same. After lunch, parallel sharing sessions continued.



After the tea break, the plenary sharing at Main Conference Hall continued. I have shared my UHV Journey and transformation noticed with real-life examples. I discussed how UHV Proposals helped me to see the feeling of self-regulation and prosperity and also the reduction in anger issues.
