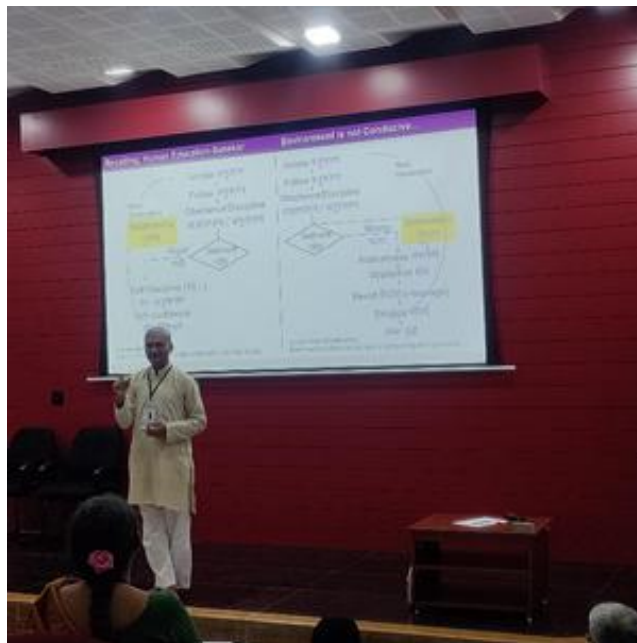

Day 3 – (30/04/2022)

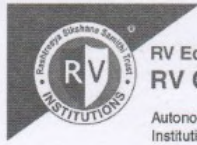
