








## Report on

Dr R. Sir Ganesh, Assistant Professor, Department of English & Foreign languages of MITS moderated Q & A session.


Finally, a vote of thanks was proposed by Dr S Mohan Kumar, Assistant Professor Department of English & Foreign languages, MITS.

The whole session was hosted by Dr K. Lakshmi Devi, Assistant Professor of English& Foreign languages, MITS.






