The programme was inaugurated with the lighting of the lamp by the dignitaries and two fresher students. After lighting the lamp, a prayer song was sung by Ms. Hema Sree. B, III B.Tech. CAI and followed with a Classical Dance performance by Ms. Hema, II B.Tech. CST.



After the glorious performance, President – RRR Educational Academy Sri. N. Dwarakanath Garu addressed the audience blossomly, thanked the Parents and the Students for their trust on MITS. He explained that MITS gained trust because of commitment, responsibility and dedication towards the students since 1998, the year of its establishment. He assured that MITS will be helpful for the bright future of the students and requested the students to utilise the facilities in MITS.



The Principal, Dr. C. Yuvaraj addressed the parents and the first B.Tech. students with a comprehensive Power Point Presentation. In his presentation, he explained about the strengths of institute, achievements, good practices and infrastructural facilities of MITS for outstanding education and skill enhancement. He also emphasized that the students need to focus on their future and understand the competition and opportunities in the world, advised to plan from day one, to avoid the distractions and to put the efforts to fulfil their ambition. After a short break of 15 minutes, the session resumed with Dr. K. Chandramohan, I B.Tech. Co-ordinator's message.
