Five Days IELTS Training (i.e 16th May, 2022 to 20thMay 2022)

Five days of Training the Trainers on IELTS (International English Language Testing System) held at MITS. Faculty of Department of English and Foreign Languages were trained by Ms. Sindhu Alaparathi, Trainer from Acharya Institute of IELTS Academy through online Mode from 2.00 pm to 4.00 pm in all the five days [i.e 16th May 2022 (Monday) to 20th May 2022 (Friday)] in Scale up class room in East Block of Our campus. The resource Person enlightened the teachers about the necessity and importance of IELTS who want to go for higher education and job to English speaking countries. IELTS provides a fair and accurate assessment of English Language Proficiency. She also informed the advantages of taking IELTS like it enhances employment prospects, develops English language skills, and reflects communication in real life. She informed the teachers about two types of IELTS exam such as Academic and General. The four skills i.e. Listening, Reading, Writing and Speaking will be tested with different parameters. The teachers were also informed about two mode of appearing for Exam. One is Pen and Paper and the other one is Computer Based Exam. The Result for Pen and Paper will be declared 13th day of exam held and computer based exam within 3-5 days. The trainer focused on Listening Skill in the day 1 (i.e.16th May 2022, Monday) explaining different modules on Listening skill. This contains 40 questions and students should answer within 30 minutes. Sample Listening audios were played and the approaches to score well were well explained to the trainees. Reading skill was focus on day 2 (i.e. 17th May 2022, Tuesday). The trainer Ms. Sindhu informed that 40 questions will be given and different types of Questions and the techniques to score well. Writing skill was covered on day 3 (i.e. 18th May 2022, Wednesday). It contains Two different task and task 1 focuses on Graph, Table, Chart, Diagram, Letter Writing and Task 2

focuses on Essay Writing. The trainer elaborated with adequate examples for each task. Speaking skill was focuses on Day 4 (i.e. 19th May 2022, Thursday). The first part of speaking skill on 4-5 minutes of speech with 3-4 topics. The speaking skill will be one to one with Examiner. The trainer played sample recorded speech of a candidate and pointed out the areas where students have to focus more. She also covered Part-2 and Part-3 of Speaking skill. The total time allotted for speaking skill is 11-14 minutes. The trainer, on Day-5 (i.e 20th May 2022), gave a little more clarity on Speaking skill modules and showed a clear picture about exam dates. Every month 4 slots were fixed for exam especially Thursday and Saturday and also the registration process were explained. The trainer Ms. Sindhu concluded the Five days Training Trainer programme by clearing all the doubts raised from the trainees. Dr. P.
