Development of Teaching Learning Material in the Age of AI

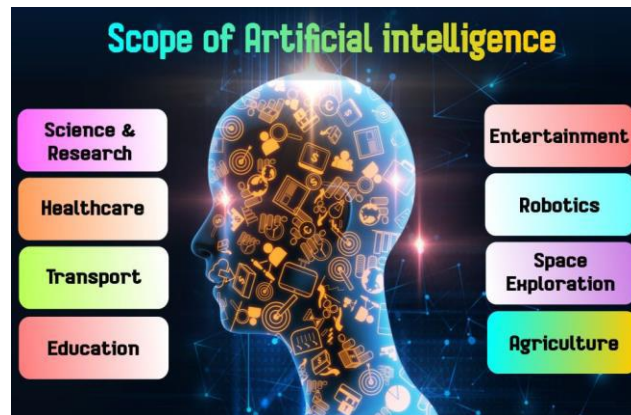

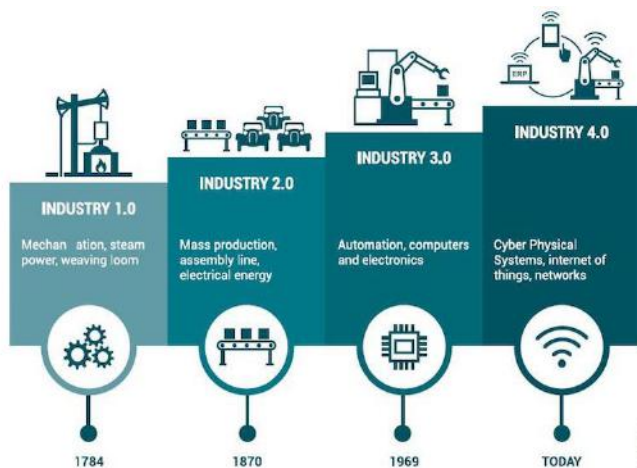
