In 1987, delegates from 24 nations convened in Montreal and declared a global commitment to halt the degradation of the ozone layer. On December 19, 1994, the United Nations General Assembly officially designated September 16 as the International Day for the Preservation of the Ozone Layer, in honor of the signing of the Montreal Protocol on Substances that Deplete the Ozone Layer in 1987. The inaugural observance of this day took place on September 16, 1995.

Dr. Lipeeka Rout from the Department of Chemistry, representing the organizing team, extended invitations to the dignitaries, including Dr. P. Ramanathan - the Vice Principal for Academics, Dr. K.
