
Mrs. G. Kiran Kumar introduced the speaker and invited him to share his valuable experiences to the students. The number of students participated in the lecture were around 100.

4. Coding Practice and Skill Development

- Students were encouraged to regularly practice coding on platforms like LeetCode, HackerRank, and CodeChef.
- The speaker explained that problem-solving ability and optimized coding solutions are key factors evaluated during interviews.

5. Resume Building and Project Work

- Guidance was provided on preparing an effective industry-ready resume that highlights technical skills, projects, and internships.
- Students were encouraged to work on real-time projects and maintain GitHub profiles to demonstrate practical knowledge.

6. Managing Pressure and Time During Placements

- The speaker shared strategies to handle stress, time management, and preparation pressure during the placement season.
- He motivated students to stay consistent, confident, and focused throughout the placement process.

7. Sharing Real-Time Placement Experience

- The alumnus shared his personal placement journey and experiences during interviews.
- He provided practical tips on how to prepare for technical rounds, HR interviews, and group discussions.

Interaction and Q&A Session

The session concluded with an interactive **Question and Answer session**, where students actively participated and raised queries related to placement preparation, technical skills, interview strategies, and career planning in the IT industry. The resource person patiently addressed the questions and shared practical suggestions based on his industry experience.
