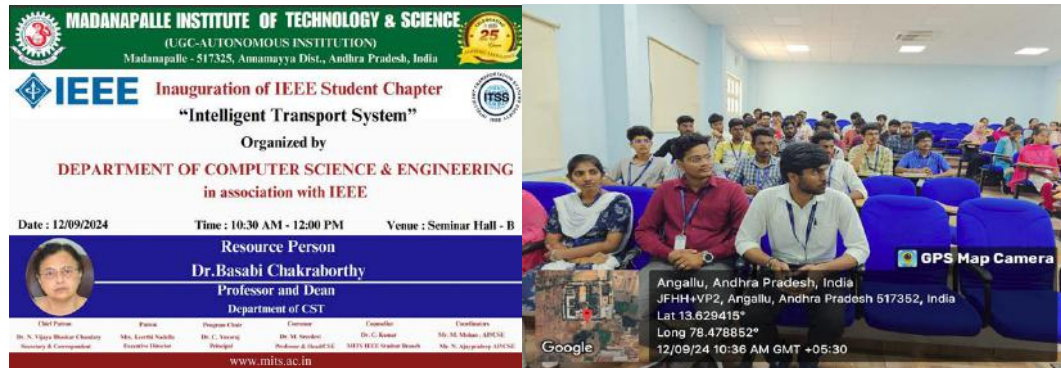


A Report on “Inauguration of IEEE Student Chapter”
