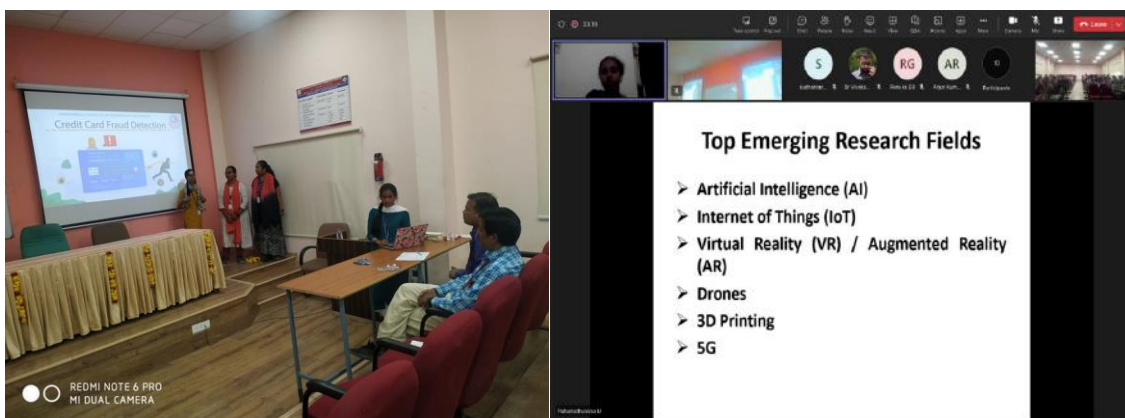

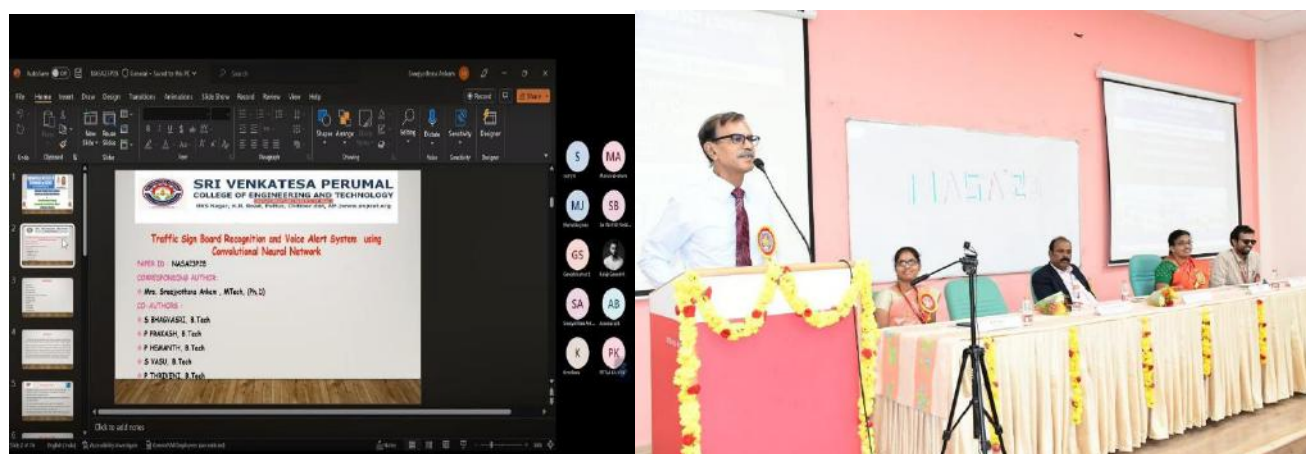


**Day 2: 20.04.2023 (Thursday)**
