- Effectively showcasing projects and internships
- Avoiding common resume mistakes
- Preparing for frequently asked HR and behavioral questions
- Maintaining professional etiquette and confident body language

Mock interview strategies and confidence-building techniques were shared to help students overcome interview anxiety.

5. Interactive Session

An engaging interactive session allowed students to clarify their doubts on various topics, including:

- How to initiate placement preparation
- The importance of CGPA in recruitment
- Managing academic backlogs
- Switching career domains
- Choosing between higher studies and placements

The session was highly participative, encouraging students to openly discuss their concerns and career goals.
