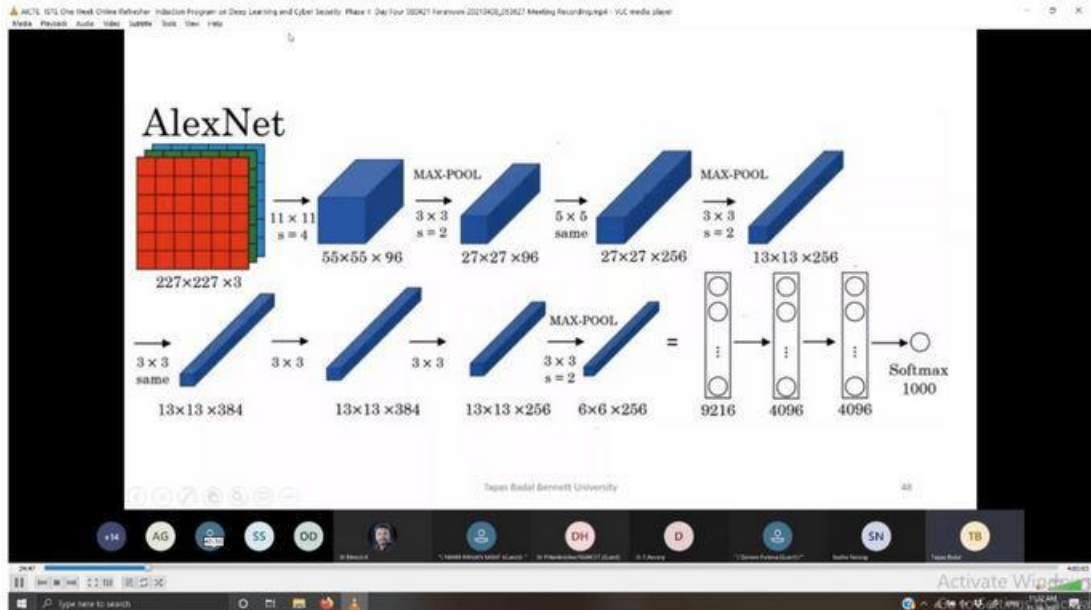


**Report on**
