This one-day Seminar on "Intellectual Property Rights" aimed to create awareness and knowledge about Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) among the students. This session made the students understand the different types of IPR and importance of having IPR for their innovation projects. This lecture is an eye-opener for the IVth Year where some of the students can turn their Final Year projects into IPRs.

The Program started with the Welcome Address by Mr. K Bhanu Rajesh Naidu, Assistant Professor, Department of CST. Dr. K.Dinesh, HOD, Department of CST briefly explained the importance of IPR in today's knowledge-driven economy. He highlighted how IPR protection can stimulate innovation, attract investments, and create economic growth. He urged students to be mindful of their intellectual property rights and to take steps to protect their creative work.

Mr. Lakshmiramana started the session by brief introduction to IPR. He started with What an IPR is? Different forms of IPR like Patents, copyrights, trademarks, and trade secrets.

An in-depth explanation of each type of IPR, including its scope, duration, and registration process is provided. Regarding Patents he discussed, what can be patented, the patenting process, and National filing options. He gave insights about what is protected by copyright, copyright registration, and fair use limitations and concluded the session with discussion on trademark registration.
