Department of Computer Science and Technology, has organized Webinar on "**Outcome Based Education**" on **14-10-2021, 10:00 am**.

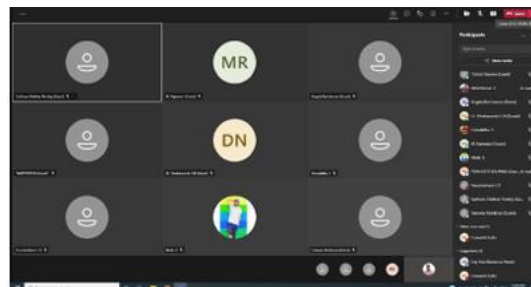
Objective:
