Welcome Address

He graciously welcomed the parents, faculty members, and students, and stressed the vital role of parental involvement in enhancing students academic performance. He further explained that the purpose of organizing the meeting was to build a supportive platform where parents and teachers can collaborate effectively for the overall academic success of the students.

Speaker: Dr. Dinesh K , HOD/CST, MITS

Dr. Dinesh K addressed the gathering and emphasized the importance of conducting the Parents-Teachers Meeting to discuss the academic progress of students, particularly the identified slow learners.

He informed the parents that nearly 65 students were identified based on their Technical performance and current learning levels. The purpose of the meeting was to clearly communicate students' subject-wise performance, attendance status, and areas that require improvement.

Dr. Dinesh K highlighted the vital role of parents in monitoring study habits at home and motivating students to perform better. He assured that the department is taking necessary steps such as conducting remedial classes, providing special mentoring, and continuous academic monitoring to support students.

He encouraged parents and faculty members to work together to create a supportive and disciplined learning environment for the overall academic success of the students.

Some points are listed out here,

- Explained the objective of the meeting, which was to discuss the students' academic progress and their current learning levels.
- Informed that nearly 65 students were identified as slow learners based on technical assessments and overall academic performance.
- Stated that it is essential and compulsory for parents to visit the department at least once every semester to understand their child's academic performance.
- Advised parents to maintain contact with the mentor at least once a month through phone calls to discuss their child's progress and address any concerns.
- Highlighted the importance of parental support and encouragement at home to strengthen students' academics and secure their future.
- Provided information about **CodeTantra**, a powerful Learning Management System (LMS), used to enhance students' software coding skills.
- Explained how parents can use **GEMS-IMS** to regularly monitor their child's attendance.
- Advised parents to pay close attention to their wards' mobile usage at home and to question unnecessary usage.
- Instructed students to utilize the library effectively to enrich their knowledge and encouraged the use of textbooks for exam preparation instead of relying solely on PDF notes on mobile phones.
- Emphasized that parents should closely monitor their child's performance in technical assessments and internal examinations.
- Encouraged parents to regularly review CodeTantra assessment results and ensure consistent preparation for technical subjects.
- Informed that extra classes will be conducted by the department from 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM to provide additional academic support.

Student Parent:

One of the parents, who is an engineer by profession, addressed the gathering during the Parents-Teachers Meeting. She expressed her gratitude to the Head of the Department and faculty members for organizing the meeting to discuss students' academic progress.
