- 1. Aptitude Development: Importance of consistent practice with quantitative, logical reasoning, and verbal ability to clear initial screening tests.
- 2. Technical Proficiency: Building a strong foundation in core subjects relevant to one's field, along with developing a basic understanding of coding and programming, especially for students from non-CS/IT backgrounds.

- 3. Interview Preparation: Guidance on preparing for technical and HR interviews, focusing on clarity of thought, articulation of ideas, and demonstrating problem-solving abilities.
- 4. Soft Skills and Communication: Insights into improving communication skills, teamwork, and adaptability, which are essential for corporate culture.

Program Outcomes

The session aligned with the following program outcomes:

- 1. Enhancing problem-solving and critical-thinking skills among students to prepare them for aptitude tests and technical interviews.
- 2. Improving technical skills and knowledge relevant to their respective fields, which are vital for technical interviews.
- 3. Developing interpersonal skills, especially communication, which plays a crucial role in the interview process and future corporate life.


