**About The Event:**

The **01st Annual Clothes Collection and Distribution Drive**, organized by the Department of Electrical & Electronics Engineering in collaboration with the National Service Scheme (NSS) and the MITS Foundation, was a commendable initiative aimed at supporting underprivileged communities. The event began with a **collection drive** held from **28th October to 6th November 2024**, where students, faculty, and staff enthusiastically contributed gently used and new clothes. 346 Clothes were collected, out of only 281 clothes are considered to be reused. That clothes have been given to dhobi for ironing.
