**IEEE Day 2022** Celebration was held in MITS, Madanapalle, on 14.10.2022. This event focused on the theme **Leveraging Technology For Better Tomorrow**. The Inauguration of this event was held in Seminar Hall D at 10.15 AM with 150 participants. IEEE Student Branch coordinator, MITS, Dr. Velumani M gave the welcome address and briefed about this event. Later, Dr. Basabi Chakraborty, Dean CST, shared her passion for IEEE and suggested initiating the women in engineering under IEEE student Branch. Then, Dr. Ramanathan, Vice Principal, Academics, discussed IEEE day celebrations and motivated the students to present their project works in IEEE journals and conferences. Later, Prof. Goutham Chakraborty, Dean CSE, gave his remarks on IEEE Day celebrations and motivated students to take up and participate in IEEE activities.

After the inauguration session, the CSE, ECE, and EEE departments arranged guest lectures related to the above theme from 1 to 2 PM. The Department of CSE has arranged a guest lecture **Prof. Qiangfu Zhao**, SMIEEE from the University of Aizu, Japan, delivered his lecture on deep learning concepts to faculties and students of CSE and its allied branches. Prof. Qiangfu Zhao delivered his talk **online** from 1 to 2.00 PM, this lecture was held in Seminar Hall D, 150 students from CSE and allied branches benefitted from this event.
