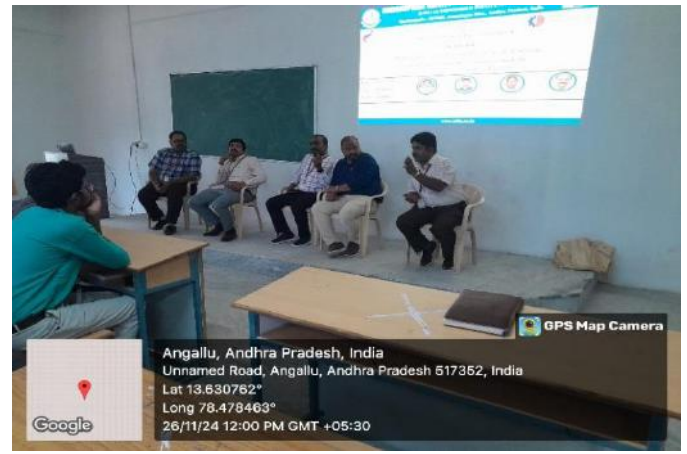

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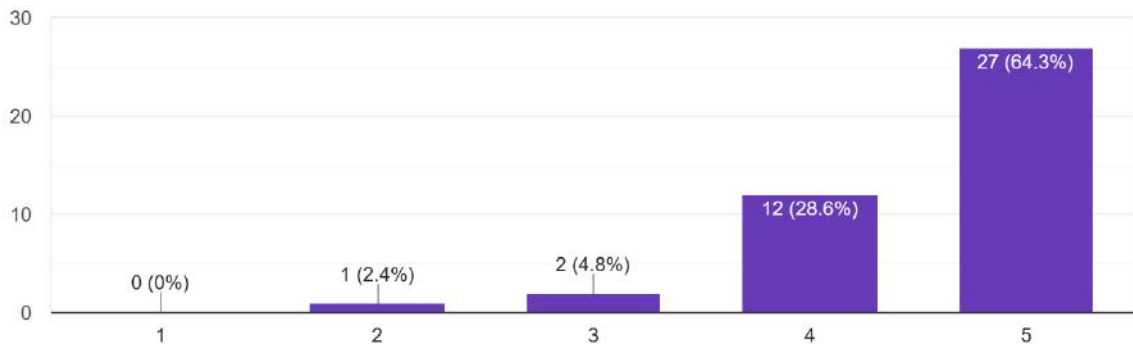

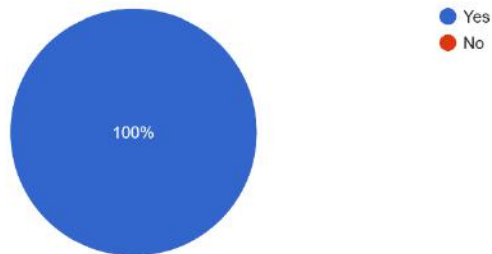
How would you rate the quality of the content shared during the discussion?

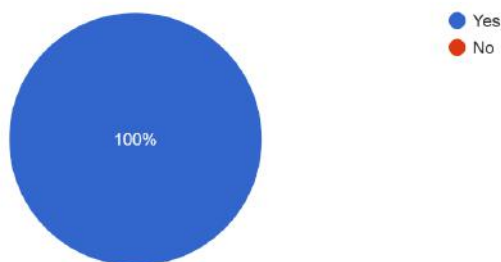
Is duration of the program sufficient?

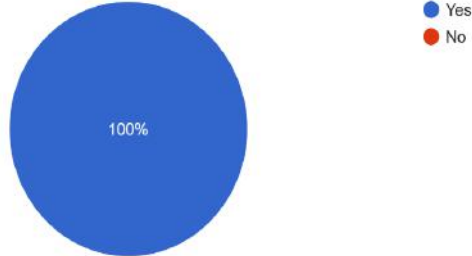
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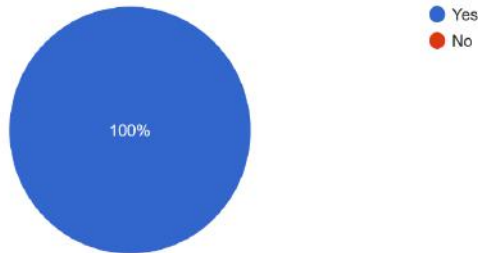

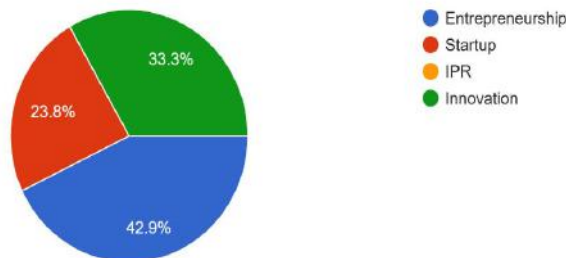
