Then He emphasised on SAP ABAP technical knowledge which is "ABAP stands for Advanced Business Application Programming language. It is an interpreted programming language that runs in the SAP ABAP Runtime environment. ABAP is the language for programming the SAP Application Server, part of its NetWeaver platform. for building business applications."

Briefly explained where SAP is used in a practically by using the Flow chart by taking the Manufacturing sector and Banking sector as examples and clearly explained how the frame work solves the problems in communication and gives the exact information which is needed by every end user and also to the production and management side

Prerequisite for learning SAP is self-motivation along with some coding knowledge of C, SQL query language and some tools of automation etc.

Mr. Gurunath opened the presentation to show in how many departments are in sink with the SAP and how it communicates to each other and be very accurate and precise in giving information that is needed by company as well as the end users.
