Keynote Address:

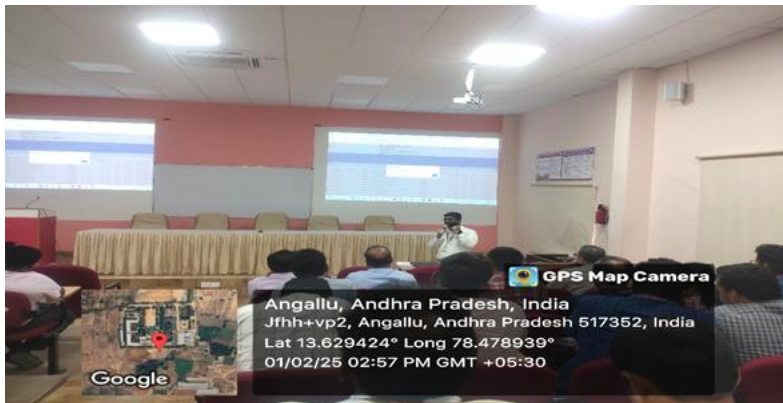
