Team Jeopardy is a game in which student teams take turns selecting a square from a grid that is organized vertically by category and horizontally by difficulty. Each square shows the number of points the team can earn if they answer a question correctly and more challenging questions have the potential to earn more points. It is a fast paced energizing technique for students to review with Course Content.

WHY USE IT?

It is a best to play with a game to synchronize with environment in Online video conference.

HOW DO I DO IT?

- Prepare by crafting Questions and assigning point values in the within categories on a game grid.
- Frame own questions and develop a process.
- Set the rules and divide the classroom into different teams in various places.
- Then arrange all into one classroom and select first Team to present.
- Assign the spokesperson to choose a category and point value.
- Reassign all the teams with their broke out classroom with time limit.
- Develop a consensus answer and return to full group with response.
- If it is correct, award points or else assign some other spoke person to talk. Finally, team get more points announced as Team win.
