1. Policy Statement

MITS is committed to the policy that no student should be deprived of education because of poverty. MITS arranges financial support to low income students through several scholarship programmes.

2. Purpose

- To support the financial requirements of students undergoing higher education.
- Award of Means cum Merit scholarships to eligible students.
- To align institutional practices with UN SDG 1.2 No poverty (Financial aid to low income students).

3. Scope

This policy applies to:

All students BPL as per the norms set by the Government of India.

4. Definitions

- **Poverty**: It is a state where individuals or communities lack sufficient financial resources and essentials to maintain a minimum standard of living. This includes not having enough income to **meet basic needs like** food, shelter, healthcare, and **education**.
- **BPL**: Below Poverty Line.

- 1. Reimbursement of tuition fee under Post Metric Scholarship Scheme from Andhra Pradesh Government, for eligible students (eligibility based on student's category and parent's income)
- 2. Means cum Merit scholarships from Central Govt.
- 3. Means cum Merit scholarships from various Private sector organizations.
