SMOKE-FREE CAMPUS POLICY

1. Policy Statement

This policy affirms our institution's commitment to creating a **healthy, safe, and smoke-free campus environment** for all students, staff, and visitors. Smoking, vaping, and the use of any tobacco-related products are strictly **prohibited in all indoor and outdoor areas** of the campus to promote well-being and align with national and global public health standards.

2. Purpose

- To prevent health risks associated with active and passive smoking
- To promote clean and healthy spaces for all stakeholders
- To align institutional practices with **UN SDG 3 –Good Health and Well-Being (Smoke free policy)**.

3. Scope

This policy applies to:

- All **students, faculty, administrative staff, support personnel, visitors, and vendors**
- All **campus premises**, including academic buildings, hostels, canteens, parking, playgrounds, and staff quarters

4. Definitions

- **Smoking:** The act of inhaling, exhaling, or possessing lighted tobacco or any similar substance.
- **Tobacco Products:** Includes cigarettes, cigars, bidi, hookah, e-cigarettes, vaping devices, and smokeless forms such as gutkha or khaini.

5. Policy Provisions

1. **Smoking is strictly prohibited** in all areas within campus boundaries, including indoor, outdoor, and public spaces.
2. **No sale or advertisement of tobacco products** is permitted within 100 yards of the institution (per COTPA Act 2003).
3. **No designated smoking zones** shall be allowed within the campus.
4. Awareness campaigns will be conducted periodically through **NSS/NCC/Health Club**.
5. Signboards stating “This is a Smoke-Free Campus” will be displayed at all major locations.

6. Implementation & Monitoring

| Cells/Departments Responsible | Responsibility |

7. Violations & Penalties

- First-time offenders will receive a **written warning** and **counseling**.
- Repeated violations may lead to:
 - Disciplinary action under the student/staff conduct rules
 - Community service or awareness campaign participation
