Mr. Eswara Reddy, SAP FICO consultant, Kripen IT solutions, Bangalore has invited to deliver a guest lecture. Mr. Eswara Reddy is currently working as SAP FICO Trainer and consultant and has over 8 years of rich experience. The resource person has touched upon the following topics one by one manner.

The session started with the introduction of the resource person Mr. Eswara Reddy briefly to the students by Mr. B. Sreekanth, Assistant Professor, Department of MBA. Dr. D. Pradeep Kumar, PAARC Cell coordinator, has addressed the audience and requested them to learn about the new technologies like ERP for better career growth. Lastly, Dr. K. V. Introduction of SAP software to students:

The speaker introduced SAP as a leading enterprise resource planning (ERP) software that integrates core business processes, such as finance, human resources, supply chain, and customer relationship management. He also introduced the students the other ERP platforms similar to SAP in a brief manner.

Importance of SAP in global business operations:

He introduced the Key modules relevant for MBA students such as SAP FI/CO (Finance and Controlling), SAP HR (Human Resources), SAP MM (Material Management), and SAP SD (Sales and Distribution and requirements to pursue the course.



Career Opportunities in SAP:

The speaker elaborated on various career paths within the SAP ecosystem, including roles such as SAP Consultant (Functional and Technical), Business Analyst with SAP expertise, SAP Project Manager, Industry-specific SAP roles (e.g., in manufacturing, retail, or healthcare).

The lecture emphasized the demand for SAP professionals across industries due to digital transformation and ERP adoption. He also provided practical explanation of how to use different SAP ERP applications.

MBA students were advised on how their business acumen can be combined with SAP knowledge to deliver strategic insights and solutions. The session also highlighted that how to use SAP in decision making and analytics and how SAP can add value to the work.
