The guest speaker focussed upon different areas related to stock markets. He highlighted trading and functioning aspects of the stock exchanges. The speaker introduced various career options in relation to stock exchanges and the necessary skills required.

The resource person has provided an overview of stock markets and different terminology used in markets and career options (analyst, broker, trader, portfolio manager, etc.). He explained about Steps to start a trading career, required qualifications, and certifications. He highlighted the role of different skills such as Analytical skills, financial literacy, and market analysis techniques in getting jobs in stock markets.

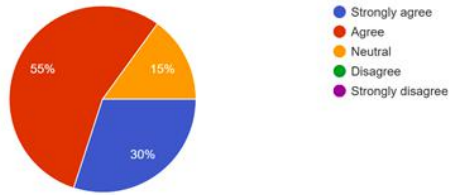

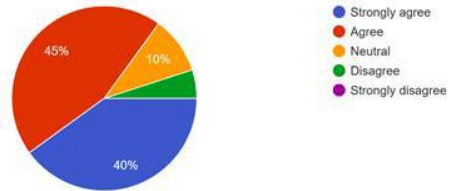

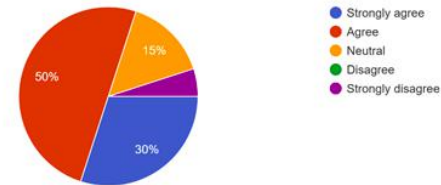

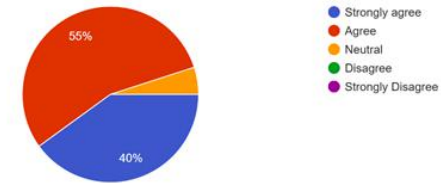

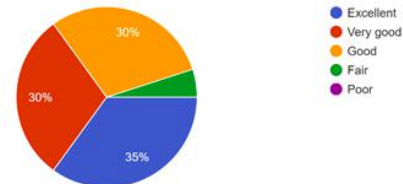
