The Entrepreneurship Development Cell and Department of Management Studies jointly organized an 'Orphanage Visit' on 15.8.23 from 7.00pm to 9.00pm. The students of I year MBA students and Dr.Prem Knowles, ED Cell Co-ordinator had visitied the orphanage managed by Chaitanya Service Society, Madanapalle.

The Students and faculty of MITS were welcomed by M.P.Anandan, founder and chairman, Chaitanya society. He thanked the Mangement and ED cell for organizing such a programme and visiting the charity institution. Dr.Babu, Administrative officer introduced the MITS students to the orphan children.

Dr.Prem Knowles shared the importance of starting and running the NGOs and Charity Organizations. He communaled to the MBA students that "Entrepreneurs should concentrate to start non-profit organization to uplift the weaker section. Approximately there are about 30 million orphans, 18 million visually challenged and 50 million handicapped in India. Having a home and three times food a day, we are already successful. It's the duty of each citizen to give their hands to help the poor and challeged community". He also specified the different forms of business organizations .

- 2. Partnership
- 3. Joint Stock company
- 4. Society (NGO, Charity organizations, societies)

NGO functions under companies act 2013 and charitable trust functions under Trust act 1882.

The Objectives of NGO & Trust:

1. To promote welfare, social-cultural, charitable, health education, humanitarian, and relief activities that will protect, safeguard, improve the quality and raise the standard of human life, particularly economically weaker sections of the society, irrespective of caste creed, race colour, sex or religion so that they may lead healthy, happy contented and dignified life.



2. To help and collaborate in establishing and running medical centers, old age homes, Ashrams, rehabilitation, institutions for the destitute, vocational training centers for the handicapped and self job-oriented activities for the unemployed.

3. To offer scholarships, stipends and financial support to deserving students in pursuing higher studies in medicine Art, science, Engineering and computer technology.

4. To undertake and support any program or projects that provide educational, recreational, social cultural and spiritual activities with the sole purpose of promoting peace, love, tolerance and national integration among the various communities of the country and Nationalities of the world.

5. Sponsorship of economically weak persons for institutional care.

6. Collaboration with other voluntary organizations to accomplish the above objects.

7. Affiliation with other national and international organizations engaged in welfare, health education, National integration, and peace-promotion activities.
