








A Report on "Virtual Alumni Meet 2024 – MBA Program" Organised by Department of Management Studies on 23.11.2024

The Virtual Alumni Meet 2024 for MBA students was organized by the Department of Management Studies in association with MITS Alumni Welfare Association (MITS – AWA) to connect alumni with their peers, current students, and faculty in a convenient and accessible virtual environment. Agenda of the meeting
