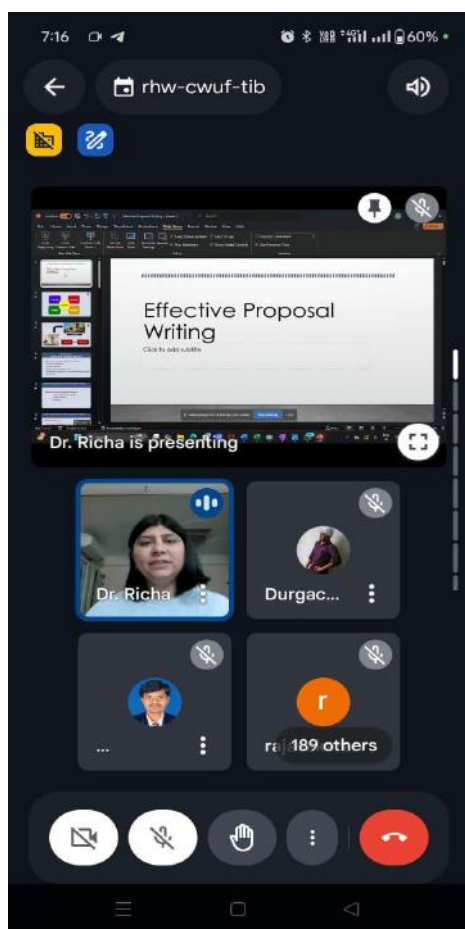
Key Highlights of the Webinar:

 - Understanding the perspective of reviewers
 - Tips on revising and improving proposals before submission
