$$S_q + (S_t - S_q) \frac{(M - M_q)}{(\overline{M}_t - M_q)}$$

where,

- M is the marks obtained by the candidate in the paper, mentioned on this scorecard,
- $M_q$  is the qualifying mark for general category candidate in the paper,
- $\overline{M_i}$  is the mean of marks of top 0.1% or top 10 (whichever is larger) of the candidates who appeared in the paper, (in case of multi-session papers including all sessions)
- $S_q = 350$  is the Score assigned to  $M_q$
- $S_i = 900$  is the Score assigned to  $\overline{M}_i$
