**Dr. K. Dinesh Head of the Department welcomed the external experts and internal faculty members for the Board of Studies of Computer Science & Technology.**

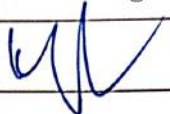

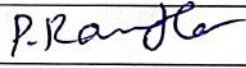
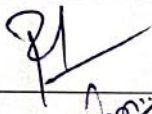


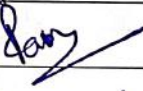



BoS Members have approved the structure & syllabus for III-year CST with the following suggestions/modifications.

1. The III Year structure was approved by members without any changes.
2. The members suggested that the IV Year course 23CST703 – Project Work and Internship be split into two components: Internship (4 credits) and Project (8 credits).
3. The members suggested that students may take up to 40% of the courses through MOOC platforms to enhance flexibility and broaden their learning opportunities.
4. The members suggested that expert lectures be organized for each course to provide students with industry insights and advanced knowledge.
5. The members suggested arranging an industrial visit for students in every semester to enhance practical exposure and industry interaction.
