

Minutes of Meeting with IAAB Members held on 19-07-2024

The Head of Department and the Academics Coordinator welcomed the external experts and internal faculty members to the Industry Alumni Advisory Board meeting for Computer Science & Technology.

The IAAB members approved the R23 structure and syllabus for the 2nd year CST program with the following suggestions/modifications:

- 1. The syllabus for Digital Logic & Computer Organization was accepted without any modifications.
- 2. The syllabus content for Object Oriented Programming through Java should be reduced in Units 3, 4, and 5.
- 3. The syllabus for Database Management Systems should include topics on security and recent trends in databases.
- 4. The syllabus for Object Oriented Programming through Java should be modified, and the number of experiments should be reduced to align with the theory syllabus.
- The syllabus for the DBMS Lab should be completely revised to include ER diagrams, basic operations on DDL, DML, TCL, and DCL. Additionally, the syllabus should include JDBC connections to the database.
- 6. The Python Programming Skill Oriented Course should be converted to a core course.
- 7. The syllabus for Operating Systems should include topics related to security.
- The Operating Systems Laboratory should be removed and replaced with an Advanced Data Structures and Algorithm Analysis Laboratory to meet placement needs.
- 9. The syllabus for the Computer Networks Lab was accepted without any modifications.
- 10. The experiments in Full Stack Development-1 should be reduced, particularly those related to conditional and loop statements. Instead, validation-related experiments should be included.
