The following points were discussed during the meeting and the minutes were recorded as below:

1. Course outcomes (COs) Assessments

A. MBA. - I Year I Semester (2022-24 Batch)

- The attainment level of CO₂ CO₃ and CO₄ for the course Business Law and Regulation is 1.88, 1.72 &1.72. Attainment level of other two COs is more than 2.0 (Target Value). The committee members have suggested to engaging additional hours for the contents on the said CO₅ to enhance the attainment.
- The attainment level of CO₁ CO₅ (except CO₃) for the courses Econometrics for Managers and Business Research Methods using SPSS is lower than 2.0 (Target Value). The committee members have suggested solving numerical problems from the previous year question papers and to engaging additional hours for the contents on the said COs to enhance the attainment.

B. MBA. - Overall 2021-23 Batch

- The attainment level of CO₅ for the course Corporate Social Responsibility is 1.88. Attainment level of all other COs is more than 2.0 (Target Value). The committee members have suggested to engaging additional hours for the contents on the said COs to enhance the attainment.
- The attainment level of CO₅ for the course Corporate Tax Planning is 1.40. Attainment level of all other COs is more than 2.0 (Target Value). The committee members have suggested solving numerical problems from the previous year question papers and to engaging additional hours for the contents on the said COs to enhance the attainment.
- MBA 2021-23 Batch PO attainments: The attainments of POs (PO1, PO2, PO4, PO5, PO7 & PO8) is attained the target level of 2.25. PO3 & PO6 have not attained the target level of 2.25. So, the committee members have suggested focusing on refining the COs and CO PO correlation to attain the target level for not attained POs.
 - Comparison of Overall attainment of PO's of R-20 Regulation batches The comparison of Overall attainment of PO's of R-20 Regulation batches is discussed in the meeting. The attainment details for the batches is mentioned in the below table.
