HoD, welcomed the members of the committee who had assembled for meeting on 18th June 2018 at 11.00 a.m. in Department of Management Studies, MITS Madanapalle.

MBA-11 Year-1 Semester and 11 Semester (2016-2018)

The attainment of COI and CO2 for Operation Research (16MBA114) is 57% and 58% respectively; similarly, the CO2 of Retail Management Strategy (16MBA427) is 59%, which are very close to the target level of 60%. The attainments of all other COs are more than the target

level. The committee members have suggested that the attainment can be achieved to the targeted level through remedial classes for the weaker students.

The attainment of CO1 for the course Business Analytics (16MBA115) is 55%, similarly, the attainment of CO1, CO4 and CO5 for the course Corporate Tax Planning (16MBA407) is 55%, 56% and 57%. (16MBA106) and Production and Operation Management (16MBA110) is 52% and 57%. (16MBA106) and Production and Operation Management (16MBA110) is 52% and 57%. The committee members suggested that the attainment of can be achieved through remedial classes and further to adopt innovative teaching learning practices.

MBA-1 Year-1 Semester and II Semester (2017-2019)

The course outcome attainment of MBA-1 Year - I Semester and II Semester (2017-2019) is achieved in case of all the courses. The committee suggested enhancing the curriculum for the next academic year followed by the improvement in the assessment tools and rubrics for the evaluation of course outcome.

- B. The committee has suggested keeping target level 2 for COs and 75% for the POs for 2017-19 batch.
- C. The committee advised HoD to frame the curriculum in line with AICTE model curriculum.
- D. The Committee members reviewed and evaluated department vision, Mission and PEOs and retained the same without modification.
- E. The course structure and syllabus for the next academic year (2018-19) R18 based on the AICTE model curriculum was discussed and the committee suggested minor modifications in terms of functional and non-functional electives.
- F. The committee has resolved to accept the feedback of Employer, Graduate Exit, Alumni, students and Parents with regard to POs.
- G. The committee members have discussed about FDPs, Workshops, Events, Paper Publications and Engaging in research activities:
  - a. The Chairman of the PAC informed the members that the student and faculty participation attending/participating in workshops, conferences and seminars have moderately increased during the last academic year 2017-18.
  - b. The quality of publications of the department has improved last academic year 2017-18.
  - c. The events conducted by the department have increased during last academic year 2017-18.
