- Dr.V.L.Pavani, HoD/MCA, Madanapalle Institute of Technology & Science welcomed the members and introduced all the internal and external members of the board to introduce themselves. She presented various activities of department to the IAAB members. She requested all the members to review the framed R16 syllabi of final year MCA programme and provide their valuable inputs.

The board recommended the following suggestions:

- Members suggested to introduce recent technologies, which fulfills industry requirements like Devops, Hadoop, Artificial Intelligence, Machine Learning.
- The final year students should be encouraged to take up full semester internships cum domain based projects in reputed IT industries/ Research Organizations/ Research Institutes during final year IInd semester, to acquire practical hands on training and gain knowledge, which would substantially enhance their employability skills.
- Members suggested to fill the gap between industry and academics by providing exclusive placement training for final year students. This is essential to enhance the aptitude, presentation skills, communication skills and practical knowledge.
- They requested the department to enhance the number of students undertaking foreign internships every year. This would in-turn increase the placement / higher study opportunities of MCA graduates in abroad.
