Minutes of the Board of Studies (BoS) Meeting – MBA Department

The Head of the Department Dr. Bhanu Sree Reddy gave welcomed the New BOS members and made a presentation on proposed changes to the Regulation 2025 course structure and detailed Syllabi of 1st year, 1st and 2nd semester in R25 syllabus under the Deemed to be University Pattern.

Key Resolutions and Approvals:

1. The Course Structure for R25 MBA First Year was presented and discussed in detail.
2. The proposed modifications under Regulation 2025 were reviewed. (*Syllabus copy enclosed for reference*).
3. The detailed syllabi of R25 MBA First Year were examined. The BoS members appreciated the new courses introduced by the department and suggested reduction of credits to ensure proper alignment with the NEP–2020 framework. Finally, it is decided to offer the Two-year MBA program for 86 Credits.
4. The NCrF-based PG Entry–Exit Framework, in line with **NEP–2020**, was deliberated upon. The discussion covered eligibility criteria for 3-year and 4-year UG degree holders, exit options (Postgraduate Diploma/Master’s Degree), and mapping to NCrF Levels 6, 6.5, and 7.

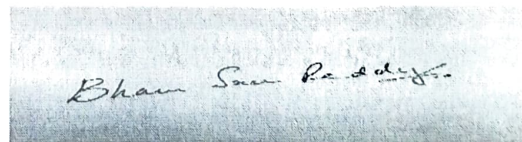
After detailed deliberations, it was resolved to approve the R25 MBA First Year Course Structure, subject to minor modifications in credits as proposed. (*Syllabus copy enclosed*).

Deliberations and Suggestions by BoS Members:

1. The BoS has reviewed and suggested to continue with same vision, Mission and Program Educational Objectives (PEOs) and Program Objectives (Pos).
2. The BoS members appreciated the courses offered by the Department of Management Studies and noted that the credits allocated for each semester are on the higher side but well aligned with the requirements of NEP-2020. The total credits for Two years MBA program was approved as 86.
3. The Analytics syllabus was highly appreciated, and it was suggested that engaging faculty members from the CSE Department to handle specific portions would be beneficial.
4. With regard to the Comprehensive Project Work, members felt that the credits allotted were insufficient and recommended enhancing it to 9 credits.
5. Members observed a gap between theory and practice and emphasized the need to focus more on developing students' analytical skills by providing them with different real-life situations to analyse and solve.
6. It was suggested that more student-led presentations be encouraged, moving beyond one-way lectures. This approach would help students build confidence and prepare them for industry readiness.
7. The members also stressed the importance of problem-solving and execution skills in the curriculum to equip students with competencies required for the corporate world.
8. Suggestions were made to educate students on cost reduction techniques, which are particularly relevant in the digital era and would help them sustain in their careers.
9. The student representative suggested that offering a greater number of certification programs would enhance students' employability and improve placement opportunities.
