Minutes of the meeting of the Board of Governors, Madanapalle Institute of Technology & Science, Madanapalle in its 38<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Board of Governors conducted through blended mode on 27<sup>th</sup> June, 2024 resolved unanimously to approve the following items:

1. Agenda Point 1. Welcoming the members to the BoG Meeting

Dr. D. Pradeep Kumar extended warm welcome to all the existing members present in the meeting.

2. Agenda Point 2: Confirmation of the Minutes of the 37<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Board of Governors

The minutes of the 37<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Board of Governors (Annexure-I) are approved.

3. Agenda Point 3: Review of the Action Taken Report on the Resolutions of the 37th Meeting of the BoG

The Action Taken Report (Annexure-II) on the Resolutions of the 37<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the BoG has been presented by Dr. C. Yuvaraj, Principal and the Board has appreciated the efforts taken to address the issues raised by the members.

4. Agenda Point 4: Ratification of the Minutes of the 15th Academic Council meeting

The members have approved the recommendations of the 15<sup>th</sup> Academic Council Meeting held on 17<sup>th</sup> November, 2023. (Annexure-III)

5. Agenda Point 5: Status of the Proposal - MITS to Deemed to be University

Principal has brought to the notice of the members that the Application for Deemed to be University status is submitted on 15th January 2024 as per the UGC notification dated 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2023. He also shared that entire MITS is earnestly awaiting for the UGC Expert committee inspection.

6. Agenda Point 6: Discussion on Increase in Intake, Merger of the Courses & Introduction of New Courses for the AY 2024-25

Principal shared with the members that as per the authorization given by the BOG members to him, the application is submitted to AICTE for Extension of Approval (EOA) for the following courses.

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#### a. Increase in Intake:

- B. Tech CSE (from 240 to 600 seats)
- B. Tech CSE Artificial Intelligence (from 180 to 300 seats)
- B. Tech CSE Cyber Security (from 120 to 180 seats)
- B. Tech CSE Data Science (from 180 to 300 seats)
- MCA (from 180 to 360 seats)
- MBA (from 180 to 300 seats)

#### b. Merger of the Course:

B. Tech - Computer Science & Engineering (Networks) - 60 Seats intake at present to Computer Science & Engineering (AI&ML) - 60 intake at present to 120 Seats (after Merger)

#### c. New Courses:

- 1. M. Tech Computer Science & Engineering Intake of 30 seats
- 2. M. Tech VLSI & Embedded Systems Intake of 30 seats

In this connection, the AICTE physical inspection is completed on 21st June 2024 and the Extension of Approval (EOA) for the AY 2024-25 is received as per our Application.

Further, the JNTUA Fact Finding Committee inspection is also completed on 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2024 and the necessary affiliation is being awaited.

The members have congratulated the Principal for obtaining the EOA for substantial increase in intake. However, the members cautioned that the academic standards need to be maintained.

Dr. M. S. Sukumar advised that in view of the approval of additional intake for 1020 seats MITS should be focussing on creation of additional infrastructure ensuring sufficient and conducive environment of learning to the Students.

### 7. Agenda Point 7: Ratification of the newly appointed Staff

The members have ratified the newly appointed staff (Annexure-IV) into various Teaching and Non-Teaching positions. The members have confirmed the sanctioning of the positions.

#### 8. Agenda Point 8: Budget for the Year 2024-25

Principal has presented the Budget for the Year 2024-25. The members have enquired about the sufficiency of the budget for R&D, IT Infra, Journals, Placement activities in view of the academic quality to be maintained for the substantial intake effective from 2024-25 onwards.

After detailed interaction with the members, Chairman, BoG has recommended for increase in the Budget of R&D from 16 Lakhs to Rs. 30 Lakhs, in Placement Activity from 13 lakhs to Rs. 30 Lakhs, in Social Services from 4 lakhs to 10 Lakhs and in Advertising from 10 lakhs to Rs. 25 Lakhs.

In addition to the above, an additional Budget of Rs. 15 Lakhs for Library also is recommended. Hence, the Department expenses and Library shall be increased from 68 Lakhs to 83 Lakhs considering the exclusive increase of Rs. 15 lakhs in the Library Component.

Members have approved the Budget for the year 2024-25 and advised the Principal to share the revised Budget among the members (Annexure - V).

# 9. Agenda Point 9: Discussion on Construction of Buildings – KK Block & NPN Block

Principal has shared with the members that 75% of the construction in KK Block is completed and expecting to complete the entire Block in the month of August 2024.

Similarly, 25% of the construction in NPN Block is completed and expecting to complete the entire Block in the month of December 2024.

# 10. Agenda Point 10: Proposal for Procurement of Systems, Software, Equipment etc.,

To meet the IT Infrastructure essential for the additional intake, Principal sought the approval of the members for the procurement of the required Systems, Softwares & Equipment etc. Principal is advised to submit the Budget proposal to the Chairman, BoG and to initiate the procurement process as per the requirement.

# 11. Agenda Point 11: Proposal to go for EMS & EnMS for ISO 14001 & ISO 50001

Principal brought to the notice of the members that MITS already has ISO 9001:2015 Certification since 2009 onwards and now has upgraded to ISO 21001:2018 Certification. The ISO 21001:2018 EOMS (Educational Organisations Management System) Certification from TUV SUD is received on 22<sup>nd</sup> February, 2024. (Annexure - VI).

With the same spirit, Principal expressed the willingness to go for ISO 14001:2015 EMS (Environment Management Systems) & ISO 50001:2018 EnMS (Energy Management Systems) Certifications and sought the approval. The members suggested that beyond ISO Certification, MITS should be focusing on the Accreditations from the national and international Bodies like NBA, NAAC, Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) and Times Higher Education (THE) rankings.

## 12. Agenda Point 12: Principal's Report on Achievements

The members have appreciated the Institute for the noteworthy achievements during the period.

However, Prof. M. Vijay Kumar suggested that the number of GATE qualified Students should considerably increase. The Institute need to put in additional efforts to inspire and engage Students in the GATE preparation.

## 13. Agenda Point 13: Any other matter with the Permission of the Chair

13 (a) Ratification of Academic Calendars pertaining to II/III/IV Year B.Tech. and II YearMBA/MCA Programmes for the Academic Year 2024-25

The members have ratified the academic calendars pertaining to II/III/IV Year B.Tech. and II YearMBA/MCA Programmes for the Academic Year 2024-25 (Annexure – VII).

## 13 (b) Accreditation of the CST Programme by NBA

Accreditation of B. Tech. CST by NBA upto 30.06.2027 with a score of 728 is brought to the notice of the members.

Principal also shared with the members that the NBA Accreditation for 7 Programmes (B. Tech. – CSE, ECE, EEE, CIVIL & ME, and MBA & MCA) would expire by 30.06.2025. The Pre-qualifier for the same is to be submitted before December, 2024 and the Self-Assessment Report for the same is to be submitted by March, 2025.

The meeting is concluded with Vote of Thanks proposed by Dr. Sremmant Basu, Dean, Administration.
